Killed At Navy Yard

Henry Turner Run Over by Sand Wagon and Fatally Crushed

Jolted from his seat while riding through the navy yard on a heavily-laden sand wagon yesterday. Henry Beal Turner, twenty-three years old, of 25 N street southeast, fell directly in front of the vehicle. Before Joseph Brass, owner and driver of the team, could stop the horses both wheels passed over Turner's body, crushing his chest and abdomen.

The navy yard surgeons gave first aid and then hurried Turner in their ambulance to the Providence Hospital. He died five minutes after admission to the institution. Coroner Nevitt gave a certificate of accidental death.
