She Donates a Farm to Establish a Lutheran Home for Aged People

An important announcement was made by Rev. W.E. Parsons, the pastor of the Lutheran Church of the Reformation, to his congregation yesterday morning. He stated that Mrs. Sarah Utermehle, the widow of George W. Utermehle, had decided to present to the Lutheran church of this country the property known as Queen Chapel farm for the purpose of locating there a home for the aged. This generous gift will enable the Lutheran church to carry out the project contemplated for some years of establishing such a home. This farm containing twenty-seven acres is near the Ivy City property. As soon as possible the necessary buildings will be erected and all the arrangements will be made to carry out the objects of this gift. Mrs. Utermehle some time ago as a memorial to her husband had the interior of the Church of the Reformation beautifully decorated and refitted.
