Death of Capt. George Wagner.

Capt. George Wagner, a well known river man, died Saturday evening at his home, 414 14th street southwest after an illness of a year. Capt. Wagner, who was 68 years of age, had resided in this city since 1862. During the war he was engaged in transporting supplies on the river for the army. Since then he has been employed in the Potomac fisheries. He leaves three married daughters and two sons. The funeral will take place at 3 o'clock Wednesday afternoon.
