Raymond B. Wailes Dies; Scientist and Writer

Raymond B. Wailes, 42 chemist and scientific writer, died yesterday at his residence, 108 McKinley street, Bethesda, Md.

A graduate of George Washington University, Mr. Wailes was chief chemist at the Washington Gas Light Co. for 17 years until he retired in 1939 because of a heart ailment.

He was the author of several books and numerous magazine articles and was a member of the editorial staff of Popular Science.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Hortense S. Wailes; a son, Raymond, and a daughter, Betty.

Funeral services will be at 3 p.m. tomorrow at the S.H. Hines funeral home. Burial will be in Congressional Cemetery.
