Man Dies in Cellblock After Sentencing

A 51-year-old man collapsed and died in the General Sessions Court cellblock yesterday afternoon shortly after being found guilty of intoxication.

The victim, Carl E. Walker, was pronounced dead on arrival at Casualty Hospital. Walker was leaving the cellblock to begin serving a 90-day sentence handed down by Judge Edward A. Beard when he collapsed.
