Mrs. Margaret Walker, Ill Only 24 Hours, Dies

Widow of John C. Walker Suffers Relapse After Appearing on Road to Recovery

After an illness of only twenty-four hours. Mrs. Margaret Walker, widow of John C. Walker, died at 6:45 o'clock today at her home in the Calverton Apartments, Columbia and Quarry roads.

Last night her children were present at their mother's bedside, and when they left at a late hour she appeared to be improved. A relapse occurred this morning, however, and she did not recover.
