The Funeral of Mrs. Maria E. Walker, who died on Monday last, took place yesterday afternoon from her late residence, 511 4 ½ street. Mrs. Walker was the daughter of the late Tobias Martin, foreman for Gales and Seaton on the National Intelligencer, in the early days of Washington city, who was killed by Devaughn in 1826. Mrs. Walker leaves a large family, including the grocers, W.T., T.H. and R.A. Walker. She was one of the most estimable and respected ladies of South Washington, where she resided nearly her entire lifetime.
