Martin C. Walker, Accountant, Dies **Native of This City Was Prominent in Masonic Activities** **Funeral Tomorrow**

Martin C. Walker, 56 years old, expert accountant and widely known in this city, where he was active in the Masonic fraternity, died at his home, 503 B street northeast after a long illness.

A native of this city, Mr. Walker was educated in the public schools here, including Central High School. He also attended the Columbia Preparatory School. He had been expert accountant for a number of firms in this city, Chicago, New York and Fort Worth, Tex.

Mr. Walker was a member of Dawson Lodge, F.A.A.M.; Eureka Chapter, Royal Arch Masons, and Columbia Commandery, Knights Templar. He was a member of Waugh M.E. Church.

He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Sophia Mills Walker; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Samuel H. Walker; two brothers, Robert H. Walker and Arthur B. Walker, and five sisters, Mrs. William B. Hardy, Miss Rosalie Walker, Mrs. Henry J. Walther, Mrs. Maxwell Winter and Mrs. McLean Smith.
