### **The Will of the Late Mrs. Ann M. Washington**

was filed with the register of wills yesterday. To Mr. W.D. Davidge, as trustee for her daughter, Fannie W. Reading, she leaves a section (40 acres) of land in California, to be divided at her death among her five children. This bequest, a chargeable with the sum of \$4,000, payable to her daughter Miss Elizabeth L. Washington, within two years after her death. The house and lot No. 416 6th street northwest is left to Anna L. Davidge and Elizabeth L. Washington, as tenants in common in fee simple, one undivided third to the former and two-thirds to the latter. All other real estate is to be equally divided among the four children of the deceased. All the household furniture and personal property is left to Elizabeth L. Washington. Walter D. Davidge is appointed sole executor.
