Lawrence Washington Descendant Dies Here

Miss Elizabeth Westwood Washington, a descendant of Lawrence Washington, half brother of George Washington, died Wednesday after an illness of several months at her home, 2724 Ontario road N.W.

Miss Washington was born near Manassas, Va., the daughter of the late William and Frances Virginia Washington. She had made her home here since she was a young woman. In early life she worked as a telegraph operator in one of the old railroad stations. Later she became an employee first of the Treasury Department and then of the General Accounting Office.

She retired several years ago after 30 years in Government service.

Miss Washington was active in affairs of the Daughters of the American Revolution.

She leaves a sister, Mrs. Fannie Washington Wilkins of this city.

Funeral services were to be held at 2:30 p.m. today at Gawler's funeral home, 1756 Pennsylvania avenue N.W., with burial in Congressional Cemetery.
