## **Woman Dies Of Burns**

## Mrs. Anie Watson, 52, Was Injured in Stove Explosion

Mrs. Annie Watson, 52 years old, widow of James R. Watson, died last night at Gallinger Hospital of burns which she received December 16 at her home, 200 First street, when a small gas stove exploded.

Mrs. Watson was badly burned about the body by the explosion and little hope was held for her recovery. She remained at her home about 24 hours, then went to Gallinger Hospital, where she underwent two blood transfusions. The case was considered remarkable by the physicians in attendance, who had later held hopes for her recovery.

Mrs. Watson lived alone and no relatives have been located. The funeral will take place Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Services will be held at the George W. Wise funeral chapel, 2900 M street. Interment will be in Congressional Cemetery.
