Harpist and USO Volunteer

Anne Caroline Weeks, 87, a harpist who was a USO volunteer here during World War II, died of a stroke Nov. 4 in a nursing home in Richmond. A Washington native, she lived in Arlington until a year ago.

Mrs. Weeks was a graduate of Georgetown Visitation Convent.

She was a featured harpist at local women's clubs during the 1930s. She belonged to the Lee Society.

Her husband, Joseph Weeks, died in 1962.

Survivors include three children, Joseph Preble Weeks and Lydia Lee Weeks, both of Manakin-Sabot, Va., and Anne Weeks Hancock of Arlington; and a granddaughter.
