Funeral of Mrs. Wells

Interment in Congressional Cemetery This Afternoon

Funeral services were held this afternoon over the remains of Mrs. Mary A. Wells, wife of C.W. Wells, at the family residence, 647 Massachusetts avenue northeast, where she died at 7 o'clock last evening. The officiating clergyman was Rev. George M. Maydwell of Waugh M.E. Church, assisted by Rev. Dr. George A. Leech. The pallbearers were nephews of Mrs. Wells -- Dr. Z.W. Alderman, Harry Dodge, Joseph A. Dodge, Clarence Dodge, Frank B. Havens and William MacReynolds. Interment was made in Congressional cemetery.

Mrs. Wells was a member of Waugh Methodist Episcopal Church, where she is remembered for her kind heart and Christian character. For a number of years prior to her marriage she was a teacher in the public schools. She was the eldest daughter of the late Alexander and Elizabeth Dodge.
