## Frank West, Jr.

The funeral of Dr. Frank West, formerly of Washington, but for a number of years a resident of Baltimore, took place at noon today from Christ's P.E. Church, on G street between 6th and 7th streets southeast. The interment was made in Congressional Cemetery.

Dr. West was 48 years of age. He was born near Washington in 1851, and received his education in private schools here, and after finishing his studies went to Baltimore, where at the University of Maryland, he graduated in medicine and surgery. He attained a high rank in his profession. Dr. West had been in bad health nearly five years. He was a member of the Protestant Episcopal Church and a number of clubs, but had of late years been obliged to spend most of his leisure at his home. He is survived by his wife, who was Miss Matilda Smith of this city.
