Clarence Whaley, Ex-Aide in Office of D.C. Auditor

Services were held yesterday for Clarence D. Whaley, 65, former deputy auditor in the District government, at Gawler's Funeral Home. He was buried in Congressional Cemetery.

He died last Tuesday in Suburban Hospital after a long illness. He lived at 2500 Wisconsin Ave. NW.

A native of the District, Mr. Whaley worked for the Highway Department of the District for about 10 years before working in the office of the auditor. Before he became deputy auditor, he audited all public assistance payments for the District. He retired in 1945.

He attended night school at National University, now part of George Washington University, and received a law degree in 1938.

He was a member of Mount Vernon Methodist Church and of Masonic Order, Lafayette Lodge No. 19.
