Miss Hattie R. White Dead

Was Teacher In Public Schools More Than Fifteen Years

Miss Hattie R. White, a teacher of the sixth grade at the Wallach School, died at the home of her sister, in New York, Wednesday, after more than a month's illness. The burial probably will take place in Washington.

Miss White was a graduate of the local normal school, and had taught in the public schools for more than fifteen years.

Funeral of Miss Harriet White

The funeral of Miss Harriet R. White, for many years a teacher in the public schools, took place last evening at 8 o'clock from her late residence, 1443 Fairmont street northwest. The interment was in Congressional cemetery. The death of Miss White occurred several days ago while she was on a visit to her brother in New York. For some time previous to her visit to her relative, it is stated, Miss White was not feeling well. Her condition upon her arrival in New York became gradually worse, it is said, until the end came, as stated. Miss White taught the sixth grade class of the Wallach School.
