William H. White, a life-long resident of this city and retired business man, died at Providence Hospital yesterday following an operation for appendicitis.

Retiring from business fifteen years ago, Mr. White devoted his leisure hours to the study of literature, and was an authority on the works of Shakespeare and biblical history. He was sixty-three years old and is survived by his wife, one daughter and four sons.
