Funeral services for Mrs. Mary E. Whyte, a resident of this city for almost eighty-eight years, who died Tuesday after an illness of more than a year, were held this afternoon at the residence, 711 2d street northwest. Rev. Donald C. MacLeod officiated. Interment was in Congressional cemetery.

Mrs. Whyte, was the widow of Capt. Frederick Whyte, U.S.A. retired. She was born in Georgetown, June 5, 1824, and with the exception of a few years when she resided in Maryland spent her entire life in the District.
