## **Funeral of Alfred Wilkerson**

The funeral of the late Alfred Wilkerson, one of the oldest residents of Southeast Washington, who died last Thursday at his residence, 1202 3d street southeast, took place Sunday afternoon. The principal service was held in St. Matthew's Episcopal Chapel, on M and Half streets southeast, which was filled to its utmost capacity by the relatives and many friends of the deceased. The Rev. Mr. McKee, pastor of St. Matthew's, officiated on the occasion, and in his address referred to the sympathetic nature or Mr. Wilkerson and of his readiness during his long life to render all the help in his power to a suffering or distressed neighbor.

Mr. Wilkerson was a native of Charles county, Maryland, but passed the most of his life in the vicinity where he died. Last summer he received a stroke of paralysis, and soon afterwards his aged wife, who survives him, was stricken with the same malady. Mr. Wilkerson's remains were laid to rest in Congressional cemetery.
