Sudden Death

The friends of Mr. John B. Williams, the well-known house painter, doing business on Virginia avenue, near 7th street southwest, were shocked yesterday to hear of his sudden death, which occurred yesterday morning, at his residence, No. 407 7th street southwest. On Saturday night about 8 o'clock, while sitting with his family he was seized with a stroke of paralysis and lingered until 2:15 o'clock yesterday morning, when he expired. Mr. Williams was 53 years of age, formerly of Richmond Virginia, and had been a resident of this city for several years, where he was highly esteemed for his integrity of character and many good qualities. His funeral takes place this afternoon from his late residence, and will be attended by Harmony Lodge, No. 21, K.P., of which he was a valued member.
