Joseph F. Wilson Dead At Home In Hyattsville

Funeral Services Tomorrow, Interment in Congressional Cemetery

Hyattsville, March 17, 1913

Joseph Frank Wilson, fifty-seven years old, died early yesterday morning at the home of N.C. Darnell, Columbia avenue, where he had been living since the death of his wife a few months ago. Thursday evening Wilson was found in a stupor in the vacant house on Melrose avenue lying on a mattress in the room where his wife died. An empty bottle that had contained laudanum was found by his side. He was aroused and walked to the home of Mr. Darnall, about 300 yards distant. Friday morning he was found in an unconscious condition and remained so until early Sunday morning when he died.

Funeral services will be held tomorrow morning at Mr. Darnall's residence, Rev. Father Dolan, pastor of St. Jerome's Catholic Church, officiating. The interment will be in Congressional cemetery, Washington.
