Robert A. Wilson, 72, Wrote of Outdoors For Times-Herald

Robert A. Wilson, 72, outdoors editor of the Times-Herald, died early today of a heart attack at Homeopathic Hospital.

Mr. Wilson joined the old Washington Times nearly 40 years ago and for more than a quarter of a century had been superintendent of the ad alley in the composing room.

Known as an expert in the field and stream sports, Mr. Wilson had hunted and fished throughout the Nation. He covered many leading fishing tournaments in the country for the Times-Herald and had written a column, "Up the Stream," for about 30 years.

He was a member of the Outdoor Writers of American and was active in the Izaak Walton League here. He belonged to Hope Masonic Lodge here.

Mr. Wilson was a native of Washington and lived at 5809 Fourteenth street N.W. at the time
