Lewis Windmuller, 71, a former employe of the Navy Department, died in a Washington area hospital Saturday after a long illness.

Mr. Windmuller, who lived at 6112 32nd St. NW, had been retired from the Navy Department's Bureau of Aeronautics since 1960. He joined the department in 1951 and worked in radio engineering.
