Miss Alice C. Wood Dies On Way Home

Native of City Is Found Dead on Train After Journey From Florida

Miss Alice C. Wood, 60, a native of Washington, was found dead in her compartment on a train which arrived at Union Station yesterday from Florida. She had been ill for some time.

Miss Wood, who had lived in Florida for several years, was accompanied on the train by an uncle, Wendon Wood 2909 Brandywine street.

She was the daughter of the late George M. Wood, former editor for the United States Geological Survey. Surviving are two brothers, Karl D. Wood, a professor at Cornell University; Herbert A. Wood, an income tax accountant here, and Mrs. Doris Wood Willis, Upper Darby, Pa.

Funeral arrangements have not yet been completed.
