Mr. Wright was by trade a tailor, and for many years resided on the lower part of the Island, and in partnership with Mr. T.K Gray, was in business for a long time on D street near 7th, but he retired from active business many years ago. Mr. Wright was a quiet, unostentatious citizen, and leaves behind him a large circle of sympathizing friends. Mr. Wright was 72 years old and was the father of L.W. Wright, druggist.
