Allen M. Young, 60, retired real estate operator and a Washington resident for the last 45 years, died of a heart attack yesterday at his home, 6222 Blair road N.W. He had suffered from a heart condition for the last several years.

Mr. Young was a native of Myersdale, Pa., came here in 1904. That year he joined the Chesapeake & Potomac Telephone Co. and worked there for the next 25 years as a cable splicer and repairman. From 1929 until he retired five years ago because of ill health, Mr. Young engaged in real estate operations.
