The funeral of Mr. John M. Young took place yesterday from his late residence, on 14th street southwest, and was largely attended by the numerous friends of the family, among whom were many old residents from all parts of the District, with whom the deceased had been associated for many years in business and social relations. The services were conducted at the house by Revs. Mr. Bittinger and Sunderland. The remains were encased in a handsome mahogany coffin furnished by Mr. Anthony Buchly, undertaker, with silver mountings, and on the lid a silver plate on which was inscribed the name, age, and death of deceased. At the close of the services the remains were followed to Congressional cemetery where they were interred. The following were the pall-bearers: Andrew J. Joyce, James R. Smith, James Holliday, Robert Edelin, Thomas Griffin and David Moore.
