### **Washington Teacher Dies In Portland, Me.**

#### **Miss Zimmerman Connected With Hine Junior High; Taught 35 Years**

Word was received here yesterday of the death of Miss Lillie Lee Zimmerman, 55 years old, at Peak Island, Portland, Me., where she was passing the summer. Miss Zimmerman was for 35 years a teacher in the public schools. She began in the Congress Heights graded school in 1889, was transferred to the Van Buren school in 193 and taught there until 1903. She was transferred later to the Buchanan school and from there to Lenox school. She had been teaching in the Hine Junior High school since it opened.

Miss Zimmerman was known to have been in good health a few days ago.

Funeral services will be held tomorrow at 2:30 o'clock in the residence of Robert H. Zimmerman, a cousin, at 1126 B street northeast. Interment will be in Congressional cemetery.

Two other first cousins survive Miss Zimmerman. They are Mrs. B. J. Cady, of tis city, and Mrs. Sallie Crogan, wife of Commander Crogan, stationed in Honolulu. The deceased was the daughter of the late Archibald M. and Eliza F. Zimmerman.
