Death of Miss Zurhorst Generally Regretted

She Passed Away in Nova Scotia After an Illness of Several Months

The death in Kempville, Nova Scotia, on Thursday of Grace Marie Zurhorst has been learned with deep regret by her young friends. She had been Nova Scotia several months trying to regain the health lost through an illness which began last winter.

It is expected the body will be brought to Washington some time tonight, and funeral services will be held at 4 o'clock tomorrow afternoon from the home of her parents, Mr. and Mrs. George P. Zurhorst, 233 Third street, southeast. The Rev. Dr. Evans, pastor of the Metropolitan Church will conduct the services.

Miss Zurhorst had been in excellent health until last winter, when she suffered an attack of pulmonary trouble, from which she never recovered. In the hope of receiving benefit she went to Falls Church, Va., and other places where it was thought pure air would do much to restore her, and finally she was sent north. She was in her fifteenth year, and was extremely popular with the young people of Capitol Hill.
