9/27/1918 Appointed Private 1st Class, original vacancy.

1/17/1892 Appointed Private 1st Class.
6/1/1892 Tried. Conduct unbecoming an officer. Charges dismissed.
3/1/1899 Promoted to Private 2nd Class, vice F.L. Allen retired.
7/1/1904 Promoted to Sergeant, vice G.H. Williams promoted.
7/6/1905 Charged with neglect of duty. Guilty. Be deprived of 2 days leave and warned.
6/16/1909 Mounted on horse, vice J.E. Hartman dismounted.
2/5/1921 Honorably discharged.
2/6/1921 Pensioned at \$75.00 per month.

1/16/1917 Appointed Patrol Driver, vice R.H. Shipley resigned.

8/1/1892 Appointed Private 1st Class.
10/5/1892 Tried. Conduct unbecoming an officer. Charges dismissed.
7/1/1900 Promoted to Private 2nd Class, original vacancy.
1/26/1901 Tried. Conduct unbecoming an officer and intoxication. Charges dismissed.
2/10/1894 Mounted on horse.
7/9/1904 Tried. Intoxication. Guilty. Fined \$25.00.
7/1/1906 Promoted to Private 3rd Class, original vacancy.

- 4/1/1907 Tried. Intoxication and neglect of duty. Guilty. Fined \$40 and warned if again guilty of intoxication on duty removal will follow.
- 11/16/1907 Tried. Conduct unbecoming an officer. Charges dismissed.
- 1/4/1908 Tried. Neglect of duty. Guilty. Warned against repetition.
- 7/27/1908 Tried. Intoxication and neglect of duty, neglect of duty, violation sec. 235 and par. 3 sec. 49 of the manual. Guilty. Two (2) charges of neglect of duty only. Fined \$10.00.
- 11/9/1908 Died as a result of fall from horse.

- 3/9/1901 Tried. Conduct unbecoming an officer. Guilty. Be removed from the force.

- 3/14/1905 Appointed Private 1st Class, vice G.K. Carrell promoted.
- 12/23/1907 Tried. Violation par. 2, sec. 51 of manual and conduct unbecoming an officer. Charges dismissed.
- 3/14/1908 Promoted to Private 2nd Class, original vacancy.
- 11/8/1909 Tried. Neglect of duty. Guilty. Warned against repetition and advised to report to officer in charge of a detail before leaving.
- 3/14/1910 Promoted to Private 3rd Class, original vacancy.
- 2/26/1912 Tried. Absence from reserve without permission. Guilty. Fined \$5.00.
- 4/18/1916 Suspended without pay this day pending the disposition of serious charges filed against him.
- 5/6/1916 Tried. Violation par. 1, sec. 11 (Intoxication) and par. 11, sec. 11 (Conduct unbecoming an officer). Guilty. Fined \$50.00.
- 5/6/1916 Restored to duty this day. The suspension without pay on April 16, 1916 remaining in effect to and including May 5, 1916.
- 12/22/1916 Five dollars of above fine of \$50.00 remitted, see PD 0.1.57 and CO 226090.
- 2/2/1924 Tried. Violation sec. 19, chap. 8 (Failing to patrol beat). Guilty. Fined \$10.00.

- 3/10/1908 Appointed Private 1st Class, C.C. Wise promoted.
- 4/10/1909 Tried. Violation par. 235 and 236 of manual. Charges dismissed.
- 10/3/1909 Suspended without pay for being caught in a poker raid.
- 10/7/1909 Tried. Violation sec. 45 of the manual and conduct prejudicial to the reputation, good order and discipline of the force. Guilty. Be suspended without pay from Oct. 3 to 15, 1909, both dates inclusive. Be fined \$25.00 and warned against repetition of the offense.
- 10/16/1909 The above suspension raised this day and the officer returned to duty.
- 12/8/1909 Five dollars of above fine of \$25.00 this day remitted by Hon. Commissioners see PD 42461 and CO 181257.

1/19/1910 Fifteen dollars of above fine of \$25.00 this day remitted by Hon. Commissioners, see PD 43090 and CO 181981.
6/9/1910 Tendered his resignation voluntarily, but it was not accepted by the Hon. Commissioners.
6/16/1910 Removed on the charge of desertion.
